Portola Charter Middle School is a Title 1 school located in Tarzana. Our population is diverse, consisting of varying ethnicities, religions and socioeconomic status.

Our school doesn't have Project-based supply funding for my History Classroom, as I teach Project Based History. For almost every unit, my 180 students' complete projects while learning the 7th Grade California Standards.

Last year I taught all 8th grade classes and this year my classes have changed to 7th grade History. Since I follow the California State Standards, this year my units will include these Medieval topics: West Africa, Middle East, European Middle Ages, Mesoamerica, China, and Japan. Other units are not Medieval and include the Renaissance Era and the Scientific Revolution.

Students have choices of the mediums they use, as they can shine with what they bring them confidence and learn new skills.

Last school year, one student created a crocheted general from the Civil War. Some students have made Traditional African Clothing or Masks, Crusader Game, etc.

Some of the projects are individual and some involve group work. Students work with their classmates and learn how to communicate, compromise, and advocate for themselves, which will give them skills for their future education and job. Students don't


memorize hundreds of facts, but learn concepts, which will be remembered for a long time.
