Item 6. The LA City Clerk as of September 16, 2024 issued new Policies & Guidelines for the Neighborhood Council Funding Program. In section 2.1 (1) (d) (ii) (c) they restricted food and beverage expenses to no more than \$10 per person and “subject to an annual limit of \$3,600 per fiscal year.”

As a result, we have to reduce our \$4,200 budget by \$600 to \$3,600.

Item 7. In connection with the NPG request from Portola we asked the following questions of the school: How will it be determined which students get the supplies? Will it be on a first come/request basis, or, on a financial need basis, or, some other basis? Who will be managing the program and the control of the student supplies to ensure that they are distributed as intended?
